










Methodology of Teaching

At DPS Khanna we strive for academic excellence with a very strong conceptual base. We have a special customised curriculum which is at par with all the elite schools of the world. We believe in producing global citizens who can stand with their head held high. We prepare students for a bright future full of opportunities. Our teachers undergo regular training at Delhi with the DPS society, which equips them to create a curriculum which covers all aspects of a child's development.



Pre-Nursery, Nursery & Prep:

Multiple Intelligence Programme

Under this programme we focus on every aspect of a child's personality. We focus on each child and develop methods that cater to different learners. A multiple intelligence programme leads to the holistic development of the child.

- 1. Development of Language Skills: We develop the child's listening, reading, writing and speaking skills.
- **2. Melody & Rhythm for Preschoolers :** Music helps us to communicate and connect with children. We believe every child is gifted by God with some energy of creativity.
- 3. Regular Home and School Links: Our teachers believe that this is a very important aspect of a good education. Communication between parents and teachers acts like a bridge which leads to a better development of the child.
- **4. Puppets**: We make the use of puppets for education under 'MERI PUTUL YATRA'.
- **5.** VARK: A programme where we concentrate on different learning styles like Visual, Aural, Read and Write and Kinesthetic.







- 7. Nurturing creativity in Preschoolers: We give children the freedom to explore, experiment and discover new things on their own.
- **8.** Teaching through the power of Sports: We believe sports and education go hand in hand. Through various activities & sports, teaching can be done more effectively.
- **9. Method of Child Study :** Our teachers assess the cognitive ability of a preschool child using a check list of cognitive assessment tasks which includes assessing the thinking of a child in both the aspects of perception of concepts, cognitive development, emotional and aesthetic development.

Primary School

In this section we move towards a more structured curriculum. Here the children are encouraged to do more independent work. At this level a lot more is done to develop reading and listening skills than at the pre primary stage. A thematic approach is designed to stimulate the children through various interactive sessions and activities.

- 1. Specially designed Educational Kits: These are used to teach grammar, numbers and fractions.
- 2. Class Magazine: This magazine is used to develop their writing and imaginative skills.
- **3. General Knowledge:** We have a class news channel where children discuss current affairs from around the world. This develops the general knowledge of the children and makes learning fun.
- 4. Introduction of Chapters through Role Play: We at DPS don't believe in rote learning. The chapters are introduced in interesting formats. Poems and stories are dramatised using expressive actions.
- **5.** Use of Language Labs & ICR (Interactive Class Room): The language lab is used from an early stage to improve pronunciation and grammar. ICRs are used for conceptual learning.
- **6.** Activity Centre: The activity room, with its educational kits is used for role play, developing motor skills as well as communication through doll houses, puppet theatre, mathematical kits as well as other kits that improve concentration, emotional bonding and develop their social skills.
- **7.** Creative and Imaginative Lesson Plans: The lessons cover all aspects of a child's development. They are comprehensive and hone their listening, thinking and writing skills.

- 8. Olympiads & Abacus: These are initiated at the Primary school level.
- **9. Project Work :** It encourages mass participation and develops a strong sense of individuality in a group format.
- **10. Nature Walks:** We regularly conduct nature walks and educational trips to the railway station, police station, post office, factories and parks.
- 11. Buddy System: Each student is assigned a buddy. This child assists in all matters of academics.

Middle & Senior School

At the middle school students are encouraged to work independently with a more comprehensive curriculum. The emphasis is on acquiring in-depth conceptual knowledge.

A well-defined curriculum based on the CBSE framework and specialised teaching from a highly qualified faculty forms the crux of this section. Here emphasis on career counselling helps steer the student towards finding success in the field of his choice. Preparation for board examinations and entrance exams for professional streams like medicine, engineering, commerce, creative arts etc. is closely monitored.

Large scale exposure and participation in various inter-school and inter-house competitions, programmes and activities are also embedded within the curriculum. Students have complete access to various laboratories and library resources for special study and research requirements.

The important aspects of the curriculum are-



- 1. Formative Assessment: This includes quizzes, debates and declamation, group discussions, role play and projects.
- 2. Summative Assessment: This is the paper and pen test. We offer extra classes to make the child more confident. He/she is coached on how the questions need to be answered.
- 3. Mentor System: We at DPS have assigned teachers as mentors to the students. The student can take the help of the assigned mentor for all problems related to academics and emotional issues.
- **4. Recapitulation Tests**: These tests which are oral and written, help in solving the immediate problems of the child. This helps in clearing all conceptual doubts.
- **5.** Research Oriented Curriculum: The curriculum is based on team work like discussions, group project work, discovery and exploration.

Senior Secondary School

Delhi Public School is committed to serious academic work for getting the best results at the CBSE+2 level. Preparation for this starts at the class IX level with rigorous learning schedules. Teachers work hard with the students to prepare them for competitive examinations .

Special classes are held for the weaker students, who are assisted in conceptional learning and clearance of doubts. Career counselling and aptitude tests are conducted to help them make the right career choices.

Various combination of subjects are offered so that students can pursue their desired courses of study later in life.

Evening Sports Academies are also run to help children excel in a particular sport of their choice. Inter-DPS and Inter-House matches are played regularly to increase the confidence of the players.

Co – Curricular Activities & Clubs

In keeping with the school's philosophy and its belief in the multiple intelligence theory, the learning areas apart from the five broad based academic areas are given a lot of weightage. Therefore the performing and theatre arts (drama, dance and Indian and western music) and the visual arts (painting, sketching, design, sculpture) are an important part of the curriculum. The programme is designed to enable students to get equal opportunity to participate in quality programmes.

Clubs and hobby classes are held on every Saturday. The children can be found busy with cooking, gardening, needlework, aerobics, art, dance and dramatics. The staff members supervise every activity meticulously.

Music Room: Western and classical Indian music is taught to the children. Each child is encouraged to play at least one musical instrument. We offer sitar, guitar, tabla, drums, flute etc. Our school choir has won many prizes at the Inter DPS competitions. ICR rooms are used to impart knowledge about music and its various forms along with knowledge of the great Indian and Western exponents of the music world.

Dance Room: Music, rhythm and dance are an important part of our curriculum. Our children are well versed in classical dance forms. Folk dances and Latin dance forms are also taught. The dance timetable also features the ICR rooms where the children are taught the origin and the history of the various dance forms.

Art Room: Children love their art period and are at their creative best in the Art Room. Our calendar covers all genres of art from sculpture to painting and sketching. Children learn collage making to origami, glass painting etc. We also have a project called Best Out of Waste, where children create objects of art out of waste material. History of Art is also taught with the help of interactive classrooms.

Computer Education

Delhi Public School Khanna has well equipped computer labs. Computer education is imparted to students from Grade I onwards as a part of their curriculum. India has excelled in Information Technology and is widely recognized as the brainpower capital of the world. Computer Sciences offer a fantastic career as well as business opportunities for which our students are prepared throughout their school years.



English Speaking & Personality Development

Classes

Today English has emerged as a language for survival in this competitive world. We at Delhi Public School offer special classes for spoken English with emphasis on diction, pronunciation and vocabulary building. This ensures that our students are perfectly fluent in the language and are equipped to use it with confidence to their advantage in the world. The language lab is used extensively for this.

Personality development classes encompass skills like communication, decision making, building self-confidence, goal setting, peer relationships, sense of responsibility and family values. Special personality development professionals conduct these classes.





Library

We offer a complete library with a collection of the latest Indian and foreign editions on a variety of subjects that would meet each child's intellectual needs. An electronic database allows students to search for a book of their interest conveniently.

Resource Centre

Sometimes children have certain hidden disabilities such as Dyslexia. This learning disability requires a trained teacher to identify it and help the child deal with it through special learning techniques. We offer caring and professional teachers who work closely with such children to ensure their successful transition into adulthood and the world of higher education.







A fleet of buses is provided to and from the school. The routes extend as far as Fatehgarh Sahib, Sirhind, Amloh, Gobindgarh, Jarg, Rauni, Rara Sahib, Doraha, Sahnewal, Samrala, Machhiwara, Khamanon and Ucha Pind etc so that the children of these areas can have access to state-of-the-art education.

Environment Projects

Students learn solid waste management through vermicomposting. High quality manure is prepared here by the earthworms under special conditions.

- Our herbal garden houses a variety of herbal plants with medicinal properties.
- The importance of 3R's Reuse, Reduce, & Recycle- is instilled in the students.

Parent Teacher Association

Special parent-teacher interaction programmes are organised to monitor the progress of each student and maintain a close link between the parents and the school, so they can work towards the child's development together.

The School Cafe

The school café provides nutritious food to students, teachers and visitors. It's a fun, happy place that the children love.

Infirmary

Health Centre and Clinic functions throughout the school hours to provide first aid and immediate medical attention. Periodical medical checkup of every student is done and records are maintained. In case a child needs special medical attention and treatment, parents are informed and specialist doctors are contacted. A qualified nurse is available for emergency care.

Career Guidance & Counselling

Experts from various fields counsel senior children on the career options open for them. This also helps the children make a better choice of the subjects to opt for in class XI. Career counselling makes them aware of the available careers and helps them in taking informed decisions.

Trips and Adventure Camps

Children are frequently taken within and outside the city to places that will help them relate to what they are learning in the class room. Adventure camps are also organised to teach the children basic survival skills amidst a lot of fun. The children learn to bond with each other and the teachers on these trips. The children also learn trekking, bird watching, mountain climbing etc.









ADMISSIONS

Age Criteria

Playway : The child should be 2 years on the 31st of March.
Pre Nursery : The child should be 3 years on the 31st of March.
Nursery : The child should be 4 years on the 31st of March.
Prep : The child should be 5 years on the 31st of March.
Grade I : The child should be 6 years on the 31st of March.

The school reserves the right to only admit students who are found to be fit for admission based on the admission test and other criteria. The management's decision is final in all matters related to admissions.
